This camp is an excellent opportunity for Scouts to work on advancement, find out how camp works and gain leadership skills that they will use in their troop in the years to come.

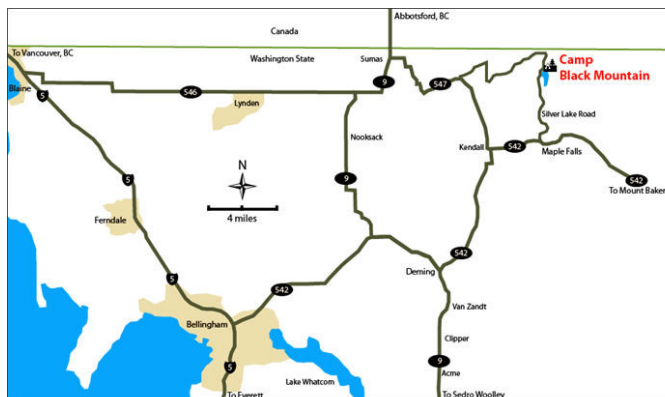

About Camp

Arrival and Departure:

The program starts at 10:30 am on Friday. When you arrive, check in with the camp director. Bring your health history forms and activity roster with you. Camp ends at 3:00 pm on Saturday.

Meal; and Housing:

Participants will sleep in tents or patrol shelters. No mattresses are provided. Dinner on Friday and breakfast on Saturday will be served cafeteria style. Lunch on Friday and Saturday will be cooked and eaten in your patrol site with food provided by camp.

Leadership:

In accordance with BSA policy, at least two adults must accompany your group. One leader must be at least 21 years of age. The other may be 18.

Insurance:

Each participant must be covered by unit accident insurance. This coverage is not provided by camp. Your ward will have the policy number.

Refunds:

In the event of accident, illness, or **extreme** extenuating circumstances, refunds of **up to 50%** of camp fees may be made if requested in writing and received no later than 30 days after the date of camp.
