

## Letter of Agreement

This letter of agreement is for the purpose of establishing the use of:

- Fire Mountain Scout Camp

The intended purpose or use of the facility under this agreement shall be for:

It is understood by all parties to this agreement, that the above referenced facility is a Boy Scout Camp and is used first and foremost by members of the Boy Scouts of America. Any use by other parties shall be subsequent to and ancillary to such use by the Boy Scouts of America.

2. The lessee agrees to provide the Mount Baker Council, Boy Scouts of America, with the following documentation prior to their arrival at the camp.
  - a.) A certificate of liability insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000 Combined Single Limit with the Mount Baker Council and Boy Scouts of America names as additional insured,
  - b.) A hold harmless agreement. (copy attached)
  - c.) A certificate showing non-profit and/or tax exempt status.
  - d.) Roster showing the names of all youth and adults participating in this activity.
3. Lessee agrees to pay \$ \_\_\_\_\_ for the use of the subject facility due upon confirmation of the reservation.
4. In addition to the agreed upon fee, a damage deposit of \$50 is required at the time of reservation. This deposit shall be refundable upon satisfactory check-out by the on-site Ranger.
5. Lessee shall be responsible for any and all damages to camp property which may reasonably be attributed to the action of their group and agrees to promptly pay any all reasonable damage claims when presented.
6. Cancellation of this agreement shall be in writing and must be received by the Mount Baker Council no later than ten (10) working days prior to the agreed upon reservation date.

7. While Scouting makes every effort to accommodate all persons with disabilities, it is a charitable, private organization not subject to the ADA. Groups using Mount Baker Council facilities are responsible for any and all reasonable accommodations necessary for its participants and visitors.
8. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs of any kind are permitted to be used on the premises.
9. Lessee agrees to provide at least one adult leader (defined as a competent individual, 21 years of age or older) for every 10 members under the age of 21 of their party. In addition, at least one adult leader must be present with the group at all times while the group is on camp property.
10. Lessee agrees that the group will abide by any and all of the camp operating rules and instructions of the Camp Ranger.
