**Please read the following and sign as noted below:**

1. All groups must check-in upon arrival with the Camp Ranger or Camp Master.
2. Upon departure all groups must check-out with the Camp Ranger or Camp Master.
3. All vehicles must remain in designated parking lots and parking areas, after unloading on arrival.
4. Firewood may be available for your use. Please see the Camp Ranger or Camp Master for its availability and use.
5. Cutting of any conifers or brush must be approved by the Camp Ranger or Camp Master prior to cutting.
6. Any damage to buildings or tent sites is the responsibility of the group and you will be billed for repair and/or replacement.
7. Swimming and boating activities are allowed only under the guidelines of BSA's Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat. NO swimming is permitted in moving water.
8. All open flames, including charcoal, must be a minimum of ten (10) feet from any structure.
9. All liquid fuels must be kept in clearly marked containers and locked in a secure storage area a minimum of twenty (20) feet from all buildings, tents and fires.
10. All garbage is to be removed from your campsite and taken with you or your group will be charged a \$10 garbage removal fee.
11. Your group is responsible for making sure all camp fires are completely extinguished before leaving camp.
12. Dishwashing will be done in your group's designated campsite. Do not wash dishes at the hose bibs/spigots.
13. NO unauthorized weapons, including pellet guns, or fireworks of any type, are allowed in camp.
14. 5 MPH (miles per hour) is the speed limit on all camp roads.
15. No pets allowed in camp.
16. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on camp property. No smoking, except in designated smoking areas.
17. A \$50 refundable damage and cleaning deposit is required on all rentals under \$100 and \$250 on all rentals above \$100.
