### SPECIAL EVENTS AT CAMP-O-RAMA

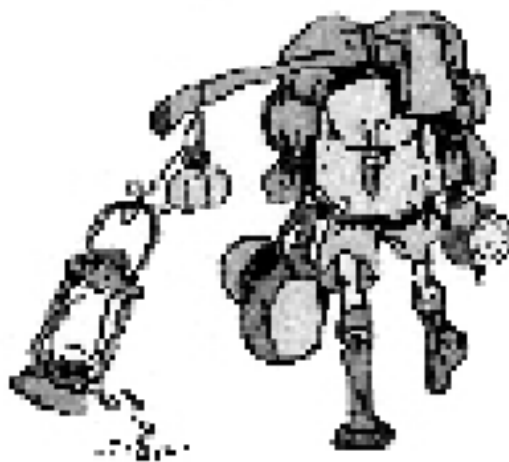
#### Speed Stacking of Cups

If you don't know what this is ask a scout. He will tell you that it is the stacking of plastic cups in various configurations of pyramids...and you need to do it as fast as you can.

## 6. Chariot Race

### Chariot Race

Each unit, den or patrol can build and race a Chariot at the “Big Race” Saturday afternoon.

#### Construction Rules:

- Chariot must carry one scout only
- Chariot must have two wheels
- Chariot must be no longer than 12 feet
- Chariot must be no wider than 6 feet
- Chariot can not have any sharp edges

#### Racing Rules:

- Qualification runs will be timed
  - 2 timed runs will be allowed
  - Best time will be recorded
- Final race will be 1 heat for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners
  - Race Divisions
    - Cub Scout
    - Boy Scout



## 7. Dutch Oven Cooking Competition

### Who is Eligible:

Every Cub Scout Den and Pack  
Every Boy Scout Patrol and Troop

### What to Cook:

Any Dutch Oven prepared item – open competition – no restrictions  
Cub Scout Dens or Pack entries can be prepared with limited & appropriate adult participation  
Boy Scout Patrols or Troop entries must be prepared only by the scouts

### Label:

Provide a name for your entry  
Provide a recipe for the judges

### Where:

Dutch Oven entries should be prepared in your campsite  
Dutch Oven entries must be submitted to the Dutch Oven Chief at the main lodge

### When:

Dutch Oven entries must be submitted to the Dutch Oven Chief by **4pm** on Saturday.

### Judging:

A panel of judges will score each entry.  
The total scores from all the judges will be tallied for each entry.  
The top 3 total scores, will win the competition.

### Recognition:

The top 3 winners will be recognized at the Saturday evening Campfire program.

### Awards:

Prizes will be presented to the top 3 winners, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place

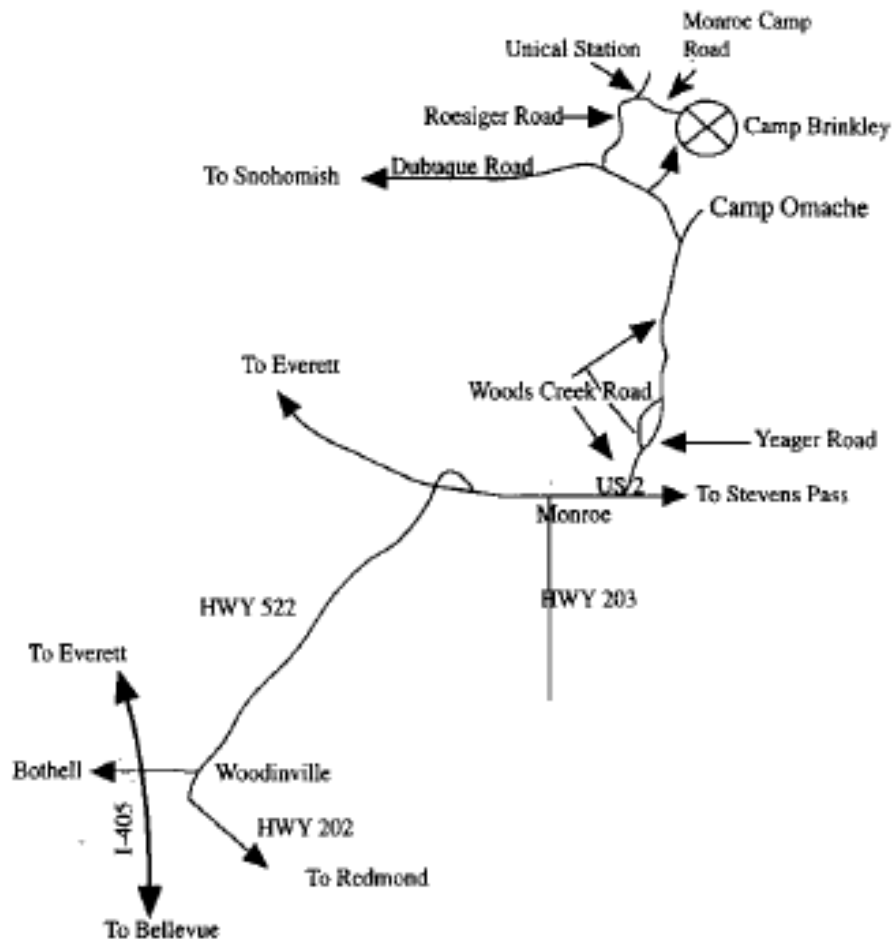

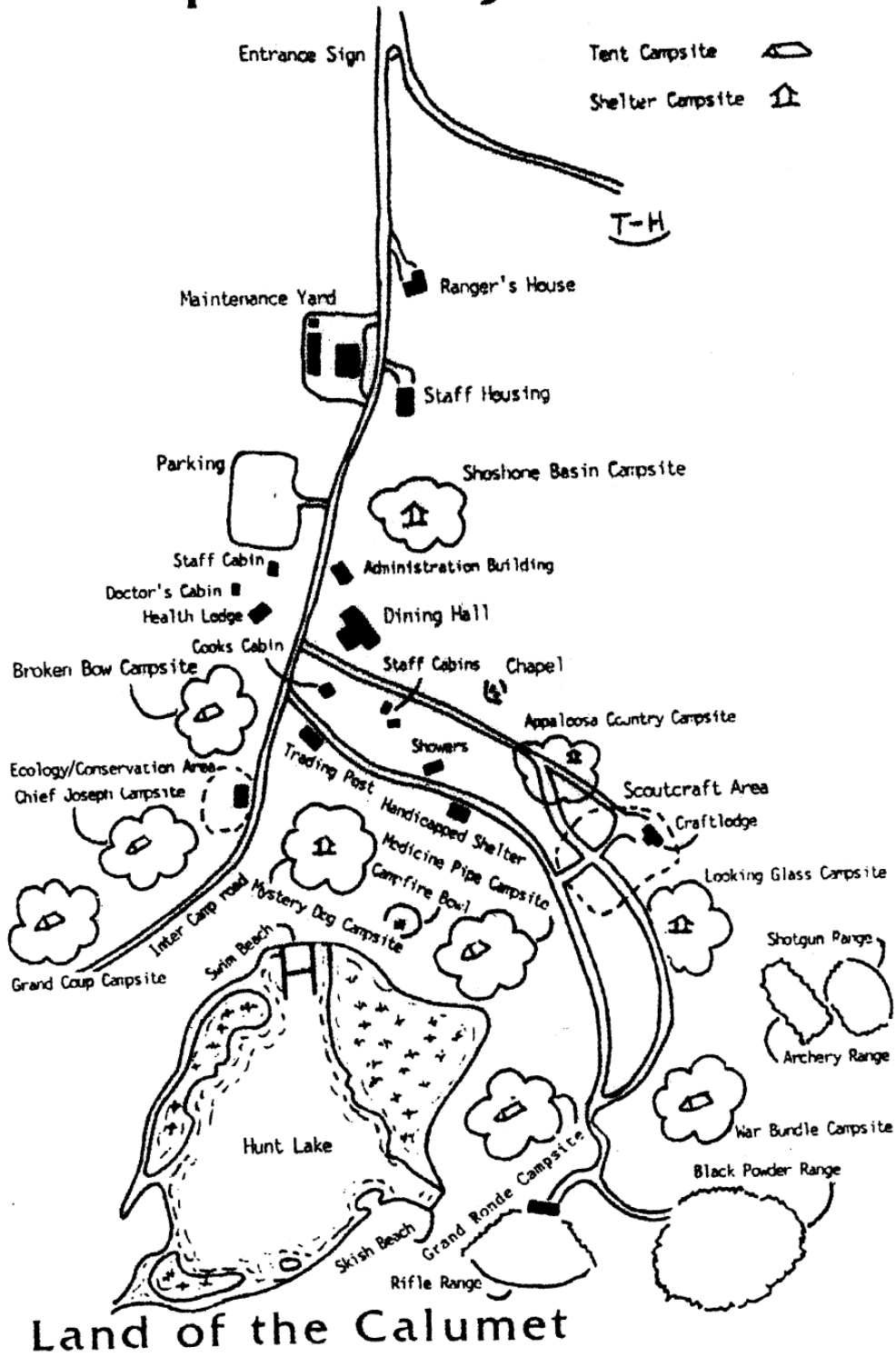
