

# 2008 Peace Arch Family Camp Reservations

## Fire Mountain Scout Reservation

### Camp Reservation Instruction Guidelines:

- Payment must be made in advance for the total number of people staying in order to reserve a site. If your group won't fit the site requested, we reserve the right to assign a similar site or cluster you so another similar group can be accommodated.
- Your paid reservation will be taken in the order it's received at the Everett Scout Office and will reserve your place at the camp of your choice. (1715 - 100<sup>th</sup> PL. SE, Everett, WA 98208)
- If the site you requested is already taken, we will assign you the nearest available site attempting to match your original request.
- A **“Leaders Guidebook”** detailing program activities, program schedule, map to the celebration, camp courtesies, etc. will be provided when you check-in at Registration. Please be sure to share this information with everyone in your group.
- Everyone should come prepared to camp in a tent site. Some tent canvas may be in place but may not be sufficient for your group size so be sure to bring your own.
- You are responsible for your own equipment, shelter, food, garbage and behavior.
- Belongings should be neatly packed and labeled to allow for easy loading and unloading from your vehicles in the parking lot to camp vehicles for transport to your camping area. A 10'x12' tarp can make a useful cover. **(NO Private Vehicles are to be driven beyond the parking lot for safety reasons).**
- If you are a BSA unit you must provide us with a copy of your approved Tour Permit at check-in.
- Many activities are planned for all ages to help make your stay a good one. *Archery, Target shooting with 22's & BB's, Crafts, Fishing, Hike, & more. (Some of the activities are on a cost / fee basis.)*
- For everyone's safety no cars, bicycles, boats or pets are allowed in camp.
