



BALOO TRAINING – Spring 2019

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation



BALOO is REQUIRED TRAINING for all Cub Scout Packs that would like to do Overnight Camping as a part of their Pack activities. At least one leader/parent of the activity must be BALOO Trained in order to take Cub Scouts camping.

BALOO now consists of two components: online and hands-on. You'll need to complete both - in order - to qualify as a "Trained" Cub Scout outdoor leader and receive the BALOO recognition patch.

1. **Online component:** The online portion of BALOO is available 24/7 on the BSA Learn Center. Just log in to **My.Scouting.org** to begin. The goal of the online portion is to make the best use of time to allow leaders to experience as much as possible during the practical hands-on training.
2. **Practical, hands-on component:** This 1.5-day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities.

Friday, March 29, 2019 to Saturday, March 30, 2019

From 7pm Friday Until 7pm Saturday (Check-in begins at 6:30pm on Friday night)
At Fire Mountain Scout Camp (26027 Walker Valley Road in Mount Vernon).

Cost: \$25 (*Includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, and materials*). *No meal will be provided on Friday night.*

This is an energetic training that will cover everything you need to know to plan and run a pack overnigher. It is more than just camping - it includes ideas for outdoor activities, games and ceremonies; information on selecting and using camping equipment; how to run a campfire program; and hands-on Cub Scout cooking demonstrations!
