**Camp Fees for 2019: Weeks 5 and 6 receive a \$50/Scout discount!**

<b>In-Council:</b>	\$360 per youth if paid by May 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$380 after May 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$390 if paid at camp check-in
<b>Out-of-Council:</b>	\$375 per youth if paid by May 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$395 after May 15 <sup>th</sup>	\$405 if paid at camp check-in
<b>Second week:</b>	Attend a 2 <sup>nd</sup> week and <b>only pay \$195</b> for more fun and adventure. Details forthcoming.		

**Adult Camp Fee** is \$150 per week or \$35 per day. No discounts apply to adult fees.

**Deposit:** A \$250 deposit for each troop is required to reserve space at summer camp. The \$250 site fee is non-refundable after December 31, 2018. This deposit assures your troop a campsite at summer camp, but does not guarantee the site selected. Your final site selection will be based upon the number of youth attending summer camp and the capacity of the campsite selected. Depending on size, there may be more than one troop per campsite. **The Camp Director makes the final decision on campsite selection.** We will strive to meet the needs of all troops.
