

Cub Scout Day Camp Registration Instructions

The Mount Baker Council Day Camp registration system is now live! We invite all families to register themselves during the Early-Bird registration period, which will end April 15th.

- With the Early-Bird discount, the cost of Day Camp is ONLY \$100.
- After April 15th, the regular cost is \$115.
- Registrations made after June 1 will pay \$130.

As adults sign up their Cubs, please remember that in order to run a quality camp we need at least 1 adult volunteer for every 3 Cub Scouts that are attending.

Adults who volunteer as a leader at camp for the entire session will receive a free camp T-shirt!

Payment methods: Credit Card (3% fee), eCheck (no fee) and Mail in.

If sending a unit or group check include contact names and phone, unit number, all participant names and online registration numbers. Once the check payment is received and entered by the council, you may need to return to your registrations to distribute the payment to your attendees and complete the process.

Units may also call the office to use their unit account. (Select Mail-in for this option.)

ALSO: Note the Support tab in the lower right of your online registration screen. This will open a small window that lists video explanations on various topics for that screen.



After April 15th we will combine registrations for each unit into a single record. **Please note: this means that the registration links you received during the early-bird session will no longer be valid.** After this date, login information for each pack record will be forwarded to your pack's Day Camp Coordinator. Your Day Camp Coordinator will review registrations to ensure the 1:3 ratio for adult to youth, and to check in with unregistered members to find out what their Day Camp plans are at that time.

CAMP GRANTS

It is a core principle of the BSA that financial need should never be a barrier to participation in Scouting.
