




The Location









The Trip Overview

- Jamboree: July 21-30, 2021 (10 Days)
- Tour: July 18-31, 2021 (14 Days)
- Tour includes important sites around Washington, D.C. Area
 - Examples: Arlington National Cemetery, The US Capital, Smithsonian Complex, Major Memorials & Mount Vernon





The Requirements

- •MUST have a current BSA membership.
- •MUST be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree but has not reached their 18th birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
- •Be approved by the local council.
- •MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete the online parental consent. (An email will be sent to the parent/guardian of any applicant currently 17 years of age or younger during the application process.)
- •Participate in pre-Jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- •Submitted BSA Annual Health & Medical Record using the on-line Jamboree submission process. The AHMR must be dated on or after July 1, 2020.
- •Submit all registrations fees per the local council's payment schedule.





The Cost

- Estimated \$3,900 per scout
- Includes
 - National Jamboree Fee
 - All Food
 - All Housing
 - Transportation
 - Tour Fees
 - Airfare
 - Equipment (Day Bag, 2 Sets of Patches, Jambo Clothing)
 - Pre-Jamboree Training
 - Does Not Include Uniforms
