## Annual Crew and Ship Recognition Program



As part of the Row the Boat unit recognition program, units that achieve immediate recognition levels of Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum and additional special qualifiers will have the opportunity to be annual recognized as a team player as part of our Mount Baker Council Crew and earn special incentives that recognize their efforts to move Scouting's mission forward in our Council territory. All requirements must be earned by the annual charter renewal. Incentives will be implemented for the following full calendar year (January 1 - December 31).

<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 22 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal) and achieve all four following objectives:

Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the unit

<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 18 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal) and achieve at least three of the following four objectives:

	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit registers a minimum of 9 new Scouts during charter year.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit has a minimum 30% of its June 30th youth membership attend the Council NYLT course
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit achieves a net sale between \$150 to \$224 per registered Scout as part of the Council's Unit Product Sales: Adventure Cards and/or Trails End Popcorn Sale. Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the unit
