## Annual Pack Recognition Program

As part of the Row the Boat unit recognition program, units that achieve immediate recognition levels of Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum and additional special qualifiers will have the opportunity to be annually recognized as a team player as part of our Mount Baker Council Crew and earn special incentives that recognize their efforts to move Scouting's mission forward in our Council territory. All requirements must be earned by the annual charter renewal. Incentives will be implemented for the following full calendar year (January 1 - December 31).

Platinum Level Units	
<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 22 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal), turn in completed unit charter by October 15th and achieve <u>all four of following objectives:</u>

	<input type="checkbox"/> The Pack has a minimum of 18 total Lions and Cubs registered.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit has at least 55% of its June 30th youth membership attend FMSC Cub Scout Overnight Camp, Council Day Camp or Council Family Camp Weekend Camp.
	The unit achieves a net sale of at least \$225 per registered Scout as part of the Council's Unit Product Sales: Trails End Popcorn Sale. Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the unit.

	10% discount on all Council program-related activity or training fees (Webelos-ree, BALOO training, etc.) and Council Summer Camp Fees
	10% off Unit Trading Post orders (one purchase for each month)
	Two free campsites rental during the off-season at FMSC
	2% extra commission for Trails End Popcorn Sale
	Special Council Shoulder Patch for all unit members

<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 18 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal), turn in completed unit charter by October 15th and achieve <u>at least three of the following four objectives:</u>
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit recharterers on-time with a range at least 79% of its current youth members and with all fees paid.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The Pack has a minimum of 15 Lions and Tigers registered
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit has at least 45% of its June 30th youth membership attend FMSC Cub Scout Overnight Camp, Council Day Camp or Council Family Camp Weekend Camp
	The unit achieves a net sale at least \$150 per registered Scout as part of the Council's Unit Product Sales: Trails End Popcorn Sale. Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the u

	Two free campsites overnight rental during the off-season at FMSC
	1.5% extra commission on Trails End Popcorn Sale
Silver Level Units	
<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 15 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal), turn in completed unit charter by October 15th and achieve <u>at least two of the following four objectives:</u>
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit recharterers on-time with a range at least 74% of its current youth members and with all fees paid.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The Packs has a minimum of 12 Lions and Tigers registered at charter renewal
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit has at least 35% of its June 30th youth membership attend FMSC Cub Scout Overnight Camp, Council Day Camp or Council Family Camp Weekend Camp
	The unit achieves a net sale at least \$100 to \$149 per registered Scout as part of the Council's Unit Trails End Popcorn Sale. Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the unit

Bronze Level Units	
<b>Level Requirements:</b>	Earn 12 Immediate Stickers by October 31st of each year (as part of the charter renewal), turn in completed unit charter by October 15th and achieve <u>at least one of the following four objectives:</u>
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit recharterers on-time with a range between 69% to 73.9% of its current youth members and with all fees paid.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The Pack has a minimum of 10 Lions and Tigers registered at charter renewal.
	<input type="checkbox"/> The unit has at least 25% of its June 30th youth membership attend FMSC Cub Scout Overnight Camp, Council Day Camp or Council Family Camp Weekend Camp
	The unit achieves a net sale at least \$50 per registered Scout as part of the Council's Unit Trails End Popcorn Sale. Unit has option to achieve this goal by donating the set required amount directly to the Council per Scout registered in the unit
